Tom Tittel Memorial Award

This award was established in honour of Tom Tittel, former head of Guidance at Downsview Secondary School and former Guidance Consultant for the York Region Catholic District School Board. His caring personality and positive approach in engaging students 'to be the best they could be' became his trademark. He was instrumental in the formation of the Ontario Guidance Leadership Association (OGLA) which has established this honour in his memory for his dedication to youth in our schools today.

This award is open to graduating students who :

- ❖ are pursuing post-secondary studies in the social services areas (childcare, teacher, social worker, etc).
- ❖ attend a publicly supported secondary school in Ontario
- ❖ have demonstrated a commitment to their academic studies
- ❖ have demonstrated outstanding leadership in the area of peer helping in the school.
- ❖ have demonstrated leadership in one or more community organizations.

The applicant must prepare a 250-500 word overview of activities relevant to the social services area and which also demonstrates their suitability for this award.

The online application is available at ontariocolleges.ca. The fee is \$125. The application fee includes up to 5 program choices (no more than 3 at any one college); the programs must start within the same academic year (August to July)

The most common deadline for confirming offers of admission - but not the only one. Applicants should check their offers of admission for exact deadline dates.

June 1, 2024

The earliest date that colleges may require payment of tuition fees.

January 15, 2024

The deadline for Ontario high school students to submit their completed applications to OUAC.

May 29, 2024 The latest date all high school applicants who submitted their application by the January application deadline can expect a response from an Ontario university.

June 3, 2024

The earliest date an Ontario high school student may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).
